Metachromatic Leukodystrophy (MLD) is a rare, terminal neurological disorder that affects children around two years old, causing them to go from a healthy, mobile, talkative child to a child who can no longer control any movement, talk, eat, or even smile. These children usually live a few years after diagnosis. DSG's office manager, Christine Hoffmann's 8-year old daughter, Olivia, passed away in December 2010 from MLD and we continue to fight to find a cure for this disease.

Greenway Heritage Trails, Laughlin Nevada

Del Sol Group (DSG) is the environmental consultant for the Laughlin Regional Park and Regional Heritage Greenway Trails – North Reach project with Stanley Consultants. DSG is working with Peek Construction, Clark County/Town of Laughlin, National Park Services, U.S Bureau of Reclamation with compliance of mitigation requirements as specified in the Finding of No Significant Impact approved by the BOR and NPS.

DSG Biologists are monitoring construction activities in Mohave Desert Tortoise habitat as construction began early 2011. Additional environmental compliance includes monitoring for migratory birds, where active nests require 500 foot buffers from construction activities.
